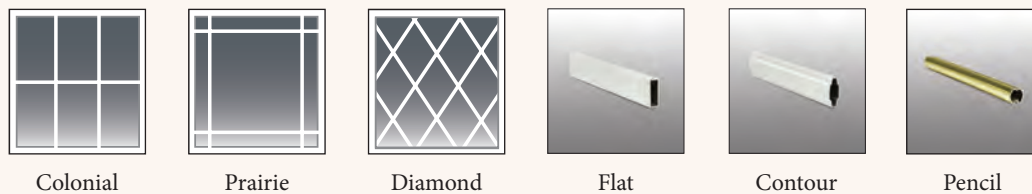
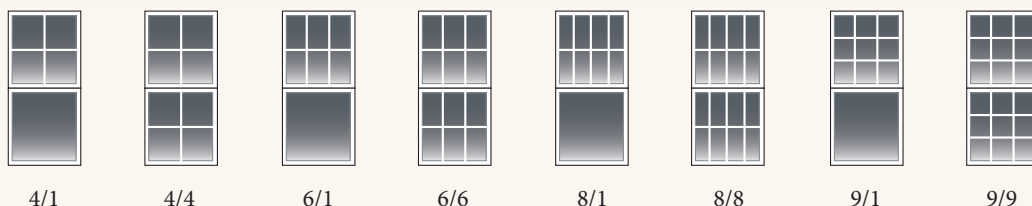
Grid Options

Pencil Grids - Narrow pencil size muntin bar with brass or pewter finish available in a variety of Colonial and Prairie patterns.

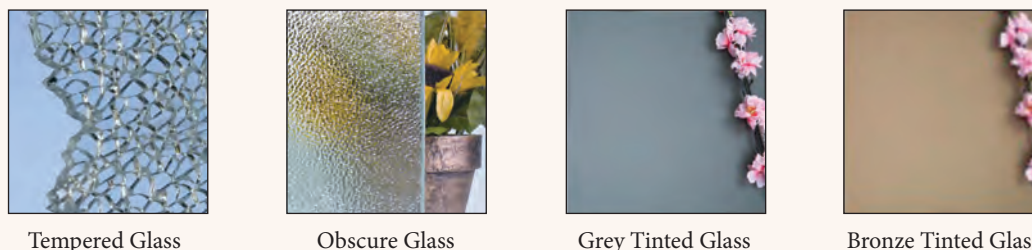


Glass Options

Tempered Glass - Heat treated glass that shatters into pebble-sized pieces instead of larger shards to reduce the risk of injury.

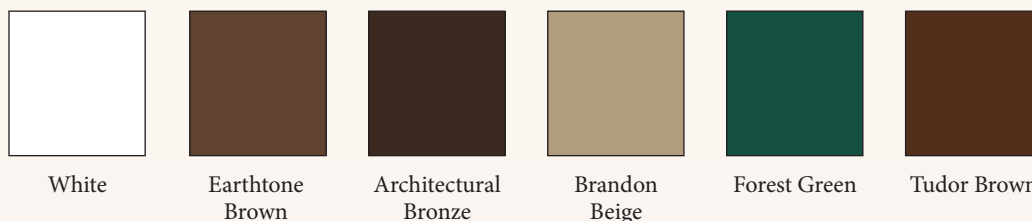
Obscure Glass - Textured glass that provides a translucent effect for added privacy.

Tinted Glass - A slight shading of color (Grey or bronze) helps control intense sun light and helps reduce the sun's heat.

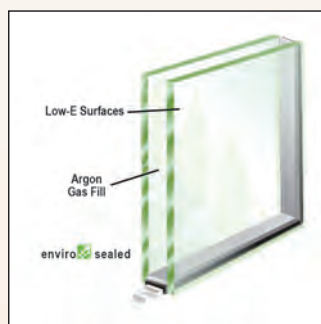

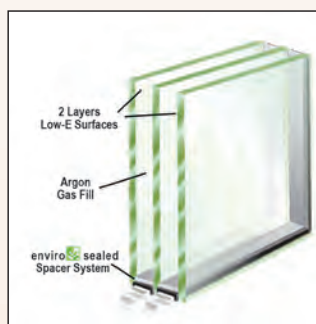

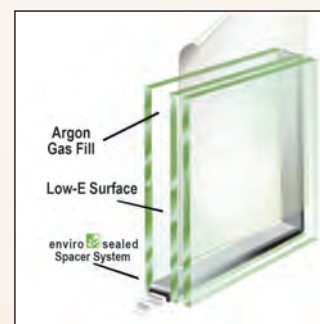
